Clergy Support Fund Campaign

The Clergy Support Fund Campaign message over the last three weeks referred to the increasing costs of supporting our sick and retired priests to enable them to live with dignity and in modest comfort. Archbishop Peter Smith would like every Catholic in the Diocese to have an opportunity to hear about their needs and how we can lend our support to this fundraising campaign to raise £4.5m over four years. £2.0m has so far been raised in parishes that have run the Campaign.

This week members of the Parish Campaign Team will speak briefly at all the Masses about the Campaign. The Team will then organise presentations in the parish hall to which you will be invited. The presentations will consider the needs of our retired priests, how the Diocese supports them and outline the ways we can lend our support to the Campaign.
